Subject: Results General Assembly 2007

The IRSA – Association organized 2 November the IRSA Annual General Assembly meeting in Amsterdam at the office of the Staff Bureau. IRSA representatives from Germany, Romania, the Czech Republic, Spain, South Africa, Ecuador, Costa Rica and the Netherlands attended the meeting. Representatives of Pakistan, Turkey and North Cyprus were not able to attend the meeting.

The representatives presented the following project activities, which were carried out successfully in 2006 and 2007:

1. IRSA – Spain
 - a. The Road Shows in Spain (3 road safety awards in 2007)
 - b. Enforcement and traffic education train - the - trainer programs in Mexico, Argentina, Ecuador and Costa Rica
 - c. Development Crash Data Collection Software with INTRAS
 - d. Participation in a number of conferences
2. IRSA – Romania
 - a. Speed camera project in Romania starting in Ialomita and Pitesti
 - b. Development Masters Degree & PhD study Road Safety (University Cluj)
 - c. Participation in several conferences
3. IRSA - North Cyprus
 - a. Speed camera project
 - b. Crash investigation & Reconstruction train - the - trainer program
4. IRSA – Ecuador
 - a. Development speed camera project
 - b. Development vehicle inspection project
 - c. Train - the - trainer programs national transit police and Guayas
 - d. Participation in several road safety events
 - e. Contribution National Road Safety Plan
5. IRSA – South Africa
 - a. Establishment IRSA – South Africa
 - b. Participation in several road safety conferences
 - c. Development train - the- trainer programs for emergency services
6. IRSA – Costa Rica
 - a. Establishment IRSA – Costa Rica
 - b. Train - the - trainer enforcement, traffic education programs for national and municipality police and introduction of crash data collection software

7. IRSA – Czech Republic
 - a. The Action (The Road Show) - 131 performances with 48.000 students in 51 cities

8. IRSA – Association
 - a. Establishment Global University Alliance for Road Safety Master Degree & PhD studies in Ecuador, Turkey, Romania, South Africa, Ethiopia, Sweden and Spain

The representatives presented their programs for 2008, which will be similar to 2007 with the intension to extend the programs with new topics and to organize the Road Shows for youth between 16 and 18 years old in countries like Slovakia, Romania, Portugal, Peru and Ecuador

IRSA received requests from Pakistan, Mexico, Brazil, Panama, Peru, Zambia, Uganda and Nigeria to participate in the IRSA programs. The IRSA – Association will try to fulfil the requests of these countries in 2008 with involvement in the training and study programs and, if possible, to establish local IRSA offices.

In October IRSA – Association opened a representative office in Bucharest to coordinate the speed camera project for Romania and to prepare a series of training programs for the national traffic police, in addition to starting a road safety research program with the University of Cluj – Napoca and to introduce traffic education programs for the secondary schools.
